FLUSHING OF HYDRANTS

Please be advised that fire hydrants will be flushed from June 25, 2018 through to June 29, 2018 between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. You may experience discoloured water and variances in water pressures during the flushing procedure. If you experience discoloured water, please run the cold water tap until the water clears. We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause.

CHANGES TO TAX SALE LEGISLATION AND REGULATION

Bill 68 provides a municipality with the option to commence tax collection procedures on properties that are two years in arrears of taxes. As a result, properties two years in arrears of taxes will be closely monitored.

Fire permits must be purchased at the Town office for all open burning between April 1 and October 31 at a cost \$5/month. Permits will not be issued during a fire ban.

A filing fee of \$200.00 is required for the Head of Council and \$100.00 for all other offices, payable by cash, debit card, certified cheque or money order.
