To address water supply issues in the municipal water system the Town of Thessalon intends to construct a water storage reservoir after securing project funding. The proposed water storage reservoir will be located south of Dawson Street and west of the northerly entrance into Lakeside Park.

The above project is being planned under Schedule B of the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment process. Subject to comments received as a result of this Notice, and the receipt of necessary approvals, the Town of Thessalon intends to proceed as outlined in the planning documentation.
