## **COVID-19**

## **GFL**

In order to ensure the safety of their staff, GFL is reminding Thessalon residents that garbage bags are to be sealed when placed curbside for pick up. If the bag is not tied, it will not be picked up. They also ask that no loose Kleenex be contained within the recycling. Failing to comply will result in the recycling not being picked up.

## **THESSALON TRANSFER SITE**

The Thessalon Transfer Site will open for the season on Friday, April 3, 2020. Regular hours are Fridays from 3:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. Please note that the Transfer Site will be closed Good Friday, April 10, 2020.

## **GLASS NO LONGER RECYCLABLE**

Please be advised that effective immediately, for residents of Thessalon, Bruce Mines, and Plummer Additional, glass bottles and jars are no longer accepted in the recycling stream, and need to be disposed of in their regular curbside garbage. The decline in the end market demand for glass resulted in this change, however, there will be a minimum impact to the landfill by landfilling the glass instead of recycling it. Thank you for recycling.
