MUNICIPAL VOTERLOOKUP

Ontario residents can visit **Voterlookup.ca** at any time to find out whether their information is accurately reflected for inclusion on the Preliminary List of Electors for the 2022 municipal and school board elections. Eligible electors can also update their information, add a name to an address, or change their school support for electoral purposes.

WINTER PARKING

By-Law 1399 prohibits parking on municipal roads, streets and lanes in the Town of Thessalon between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m. from December 1st to April 30th, to facilitate snow removal.

INTERIM TAX BILL

The first installment of the interim tax bill, to be mailed early next month, is due February 28th, 2022 and the second installment of the interim tax bill is due April 29th, 2022.
