## **MUNICIPAL VOTER LOOKUP**

Ontario residents can visit [Voterlookup.ca](http://Voterlookup.ca) at any time to find out if their information is accurately reflected for inclusion on the Preliminary List of Electors for the 2022 municipal and school board elections. Eligible electors can also update their information, add a name to an address, or change their school support for electoral purposes.

## **TOWN OF THESSALON SPRING CLEAN-UP**

The Thessalon Transfer Site will be open May 29, 2022 from 12:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. to accept brush, leaves, white goods, metal and all electronics. The Give-A-Way building will also be open. Tires and construction debris must be self-hauled to the Rose Lake Landfill Site.

## **SECOND HAND SUNDAY**

Second Hand Sunday will be taking place May 29, 2022. Place any unwanted, reusable items curbside for neighbours to take for free. Please have items at the curbside by 8:00 a.m. Any remaining items must be removed by 7:00 p.m. that day.

## **SPRING CLEAN UP**

The 2022 Spring Clean-up is scheduled for May 31, 2022. The clean-up will allow residents to place large items such as but not limited to, mattresses, couches, chairs, carpets, etc. at the curbside for pick up. Carpet is to be cut to 4 feet wide rolls. Wood, brush, leaves, white goods, e-waste, metal, tires, and construction debris **will not be accepted**. There is no limit for the number of clear garbage bags. Recycling will be picked on the normal schedule by a separate truck. Place items at the curbside by 7:00 p.m. on May 30, 2022. Pick up will begin at 7:00 a.m. on May 31, 2022. Any goods remaining at the curbside after pick up is completed must be removed by 7:00 p.m. on May 31, 2022.

## **HOME EFFICIENCY REBATE**

The Home Efficiency Rebate can help lower energy costs. The program offers rebates for insulation, air sealing, new windows/doors, water heaters, boilers, furnaces, and home energy assessments. ## **PROPERTY STANDARDS BY-LAW**

The Town of Thessalon Property Standards Committee and the Town Bylaw Enforcement Officer will be conducting a tour of the Town to identify properties that may be in violation of Bylaw 1592, being a bylaw to establish standards for the maintenance and occupancy of property in the Town of Thessalon. Those found to be in non-compliance can expect to receive notification by way of registered letter advising of the violation and the conditions identified by the Committee and Bylaw Enforcement Officer.
