Freon Round Up

The Tri-Neighbours Board of Management Freon Appliance Round-Up continues to run until Saturday, September 30, 2023. Freon appliances include, but are not limited to, refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, de-humidifiers, etc. Freon appliances can be brought to the Transfer Sites located in the Town of Bruce Mines and the Town of Thessalon and the Waste Management Site (Landfill) on East Line Road during normal operating hours. A Sticker must be purchased and applied to the appliance to be accepted in the sites. These stickers are available at the transfer sites and the landfill site from the Site Attendant for a fee of \$20.00 each. This fee will cover the cost of removing the Freon from the appliance. All doors must be removed from appliances by owner prior to bringing into the sites.

The expansion of the Huron Shores Family Health Team to incorporate Thessalon, Bruce Mines and Richards Landing was a vital step towards helping to resolve the healthcare crisis in our community.
